

Changes to AICS fees: 2012-13

Chemicals that have undergone a new chemical assessment are listed on the Australian Inventory of Chemical Substances (AICS) five years after the issue of an assessment certificate, or earlier at the request of the notifier. Based on the NICNAS cost recovery review, 2012-13 fees related to the listing of chemicals on the confidential and non-confidential section of the AICS has been adjusted to better align with the cost of delivering the service.

The 2012-13 fees apply from **1 July 2012**:

Description	2012-13 fee
Confidential Listing of a New Industrial Chemical	\$3,500
Application to Retain Confidential Listing	\$3,500
Application for Early Non-confidential Listing with fee	\$750
Application to be a Holder of a Confidence	\$700
Transfer to Confidential listing	\$2,100

All AICS fees are in Australian dollars and are **GST free**.

AICS searches

The non-confidential (public) AICS search service by NICNAS, which was a service provided to industry for an administrative fee, will no longer be available from 1 July 2012. Chemicals listed in the public section of the AICS can be searched free-of-charge using the [online AICS search](#) facility.
